WHAT YOUR DONATION CAN ACHIEVE

£2 can provide school materials so a vulnerable child in Uganda, who is at risk of dropping out of school, can take catch up lessons and complete their education.

£10 can train the parents and guardians of orphans and vulnerable children in Zimbabwe to grow their own crops to provide for their families sustainably.

£20 can teach a community member in Zimbabwe how to make outdoor play equipment for pre-schools.

£35 can enable a young person in Malawi to take a vocational training course as a carpenter, tailor or tin smith, so they can gain skills to start their own business.

£50 can buy a goat for an orphan in Tanzania, which will provide milk and baby goats to sell on.

£100 can train five children in Uganda to advocate for child rights in their communities, to encourage other children to report abuses and raise awareness of child protection responsibilities.

£200 can provide emergency support to 60 isolated children living on the streets in Tanzania, to give them the specialist care and support they need to improve their prospects.

£250 can start a Kids' Club in Zimbabwe, where hundreds of children can gather, make friends, play and learn, without fear of stigma, abuse or exploitation.

£500 can provide counselling and support for 150 orphans and vulnerable children in Kenya, allowing them to talk about their trauma and experiences, make connections in their communities and gain skills for their futures.

£1,250 can start a new Village Investors Programme (VIP) group in Kenya, Malawi, Tanzania, Uganda or Zimbabwe, enabling those looking after vulnerable children to pool their small resources and provide for the children in their care better, and for longer.
